Parsing reward into motivational and hedonic reward dimensions

Rewards that motivate our behavior are characterized along two important dimensions: the hedonic and the motivational dimension. I will first present imaging results investigating how the brain processes these dimensions, focusing on reward-encoding regions such as the striatum and prefontal cortex. Second, I will present results from studies focusing on the pharmacology of reward, specifically the role of the dopamine system in the motivational dimension of reward.
